PSATs

On Wednesday October 15th all 9th, 10th and 11th graders will take the PSAT. This is a standardized test traditionally given in the 11th grade year as a practice for the SAT and opportunity to qualify for National Merit Scholarships. Since Vermont Commons does not assess with many multiple choice exams, we have all 9-11th graders take the test to practice the test conditions and get a sense of what they may want to do to prepare.

This week during Common Hour, Jasmine gave 9-11th graders a booklet to prepare for the PSAT along with a brief introduction to the structure of the test. We would encourage you to look it over with your child.


